We are so excited to welcome the children back to school. To start our Year One journey we will be ensuring the transition from Reception to Year One is fun and engaging. The children will spend lots of time learning outside and exploring through play.

To begin the year we will be using the book 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers. This is a specially designed topic which will help the children settle back into school.



This two-week topic will engage the children through a variety of different activities. We will be making maps, learning about our bodies, looking after nature, creating artwork and lots of other exciting things!

In Reception, the children really enjoyed getting involved with nature and learning about the wildlife living in our school grounds. We will build on this by beginning to learn about the seasons and exploring our nature area. We will be getting to know Mrs Watts, who looks after the grounds at school.

Ways To Help At Home:

We cannot stress enough the importance of reading with and to your child. In these early years, the impact reading has on development both socially and academically is huge. Please read your child's bug club book with them and enjoy sharing and talking about books every day. If you would like any guidance on this or advice on the sort of books to choose, please speak to your child's teacher.

We are lucky to be benefitting from forest school for the first time in Year One. Please make sure you have wellies and full waterproofs kept in school at all times. The children will also need a named water bottle to be kept in school. These will go to and from home to be washed.
