

# Heroes and Heroines



Our second topic is going to be a lot of fun! The children will be working in role as real superheroes. They will be dressing up, making badges, advertising for a sidekick, learning how to stay healthy by eating a variety of different foods and designing and making their own Superhero logo. They will be encouraged to think about what their super power would be and who they would help. There will be strong links made in PSHE about who they are and how their actions can affect others.

In English we will be working on speaking in full sentences and making sure what we write makes sense. We will be revising the phase 2 and 3 sounds in letters and sounds and will begin to work on blending some familiar words in our heads. We will continue to hear stories everyday and will talk about and comment on what we have read.

In maths we will concentrate on accurate counting, place value, reading, writing and recognising numbers. We will begin to learn how to write the numbers 0-10 as words and will be using these numbers in a variety of different contexts through problem solving.

The children have really enjoyed getting involved with nature and learning about the wildlife living in our school grounds. We will continue to learn about the seasons and will be learning the names of the trees in our nature area. We will be getting to know Mrs Watts, our very own everyday hero, who looks after the grounds at school.
