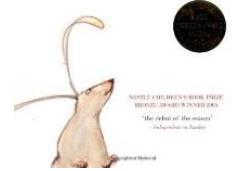


Year 1 - Wolves

Drawing wolves and rabbits for illustrations</p> <p>DT Designing and making a trap for a wolf</p>	<p>Read together as often as possible.</p>  <p>Play with your child and encourage them to talk in full sentences using new vocabulary.</p> <p>Observe and talk about seasonal changes when out and about, weather patterns, how daylight changes.</p> <p>Practise counting and reading numbers in everyday situations.</p>  <p>Looking at clocks and telling the time to the nearest hour, i.e. at 3 o'clock.</p>	<p>Visit to Library</p> <p>Build wolf traps in copse</p>
