

FIRE, FIRE!

During our History topic the children will experience what life was like for people who lived through the Great Fire of London. The children will begin the topic by finding a time capsule in the school grounds. This will contain 'artefacts' saved from the fire. We will take the children into Dunmow to show them a selection of Tudor buildings and they will be able to bake their own bread.

In Science the children learn about the properties of materials and in DT they will design and make their own tudor house.



In writing the children are going to continue to focus on writing with the correct punctuation. We will be encouraging the children to write more extended pieces and will also continue to encourage the children to take ownership of their writing through Writer's Workshop.



In maths we will be moving on to multiplication. We will be using addition skills to multiply by repeated addition (eg. $2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 8$).
