

Dear Parent/Carer

Re: School parking

We have received complaints about inconsiderate and dangerous parking around St Marys Primary School.

Examples include blocking driveways, parking on pavements, causing obstructions, parking on double yellow lines and parking where there are double white lines in the centre of the road.

Essex Police are committed to improving driving and parking standards in order to protect everyone's safety. Despite some complaints, we know most people do want to do the right thing and drive safely and responsibly.

We therefore request that you adhere to the following when parking, dropping off or collecting children from school:

- Keep the School Keep Clear marking (zig zags) clear
- Ensure pavements, driveways and pedestrian access points are kept clear
- Ensure emergency vehicles would be able to get past if needed
- Adhere to local parking restrictions
- Behave in a manner than is respectful towards others – including pedestrians and residents
- Park further away from school if possible

Drivers committing offences may be prosecuted or issued with tickets by wardens or the police.
